The following code of conduct will be adhered too at all times while on the Lodge and throughout the duration of the OET Fishing Competition. All participants and guests are will be expected to conduct themselves in a sportsman/woman like manner.

- Security Personal:
 - Will at all times be treated with the utmost respect.
 - o No foul language will be allowed or tolerated towards the Security Personal.
 - o Instructions given will be followed.

Access:

- o Will display the Gate permit disc in the right hand lower corner of the said vehicles windscreen (Driver side), when entering the Lodge.
- o The said Gate permit disc will be displayed (as stated above) at all times while on the Lodge premises.
- o If a vehicle does not have a Gate permit at time of entry, the normal Access Control system will be followed.
- While driving inside the Lodge:
 - Keep to the speed limit, which is 25 Km per hour at all times when driving in the Lodge.
 - o No reckless driving i.e. wheel spinning, speeding over the speed bumps.
 - o Only valid licensed drivers are allowed to operate a vehicle on the Lodge.
 - o No driving or parking on the grass.
 - o Be careful of our wild life.
