East Africa Safaris & Chicuanga resort share a reception area, launch site as well as a Restaurant & Beach bar. Because we believe in supporting our local community - the resort offers jobs for the locals as cleaners, maintenance crew, waiters, chefs as well as bar men. Most of our supplies, fresh produce & food are also bought locally.

East Africa Safaris also offers Deep sea Charters & Whale watching (winter months), you are welcome to enquire at the restaurant to make a booking. Fishing, Jet-ski & boat permits can be purchased from the Reception.

Please remember sand dunes are sensitive environmental areas & therefore we do not allow quad bikes or vehicles outside of the demarcated areas! The speed limit inside the resort is 20 km/h.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

-IS THERE A RESTAURANT & SHOP?

Yes, there is. Fresh Bottled water can be bought at the shop & Restaurant. Ice, charcoal & other convenience items are available at the shop.

-DO I NEED TO BRING TOWELS?

Bath towels will be provided, please bring along your own beach towels as the Villas towels are not permitted outside.

-IS THERE WI-FI?

Yes, only at the restaurant.

-IS THERE CELLPHONE RECEPTION?

Yes, please remember to switch on your roaming if you are not using a Mozambican sim card.

-ARE PETS ALLOWED?

Unfortunately not, no pets are allowed at the resort.



-DO YOU HAVE CREDIT CARD FACILITIES?

Yes, there is card facilities at the reception, restaurant & shop.

-WHERE CAN WE EXCHANGE MONEY?

All ATM's & banks exchange money, you can also exchange at the BP garage before Komatipoort in SA. The local currency is METICALS.

-WHERE CAN I BUY FRESH SEAFOOD?

The restaurant serves delicious fresh seafood, but if you prefer to prepare it yourself. Fresh seafood can be bought in Xai Xai , at the market.

-DO I NEED A 4X4?

Driving inside the resort – Yes, but you can reach the resort in a normal car. Please arrange ahead of time should you need a guard to watch your vehicle at the reception area.

-CAN I BRING MY QUAD BIKE / JET SKI?

You are welcome, all permits can be bought from reception. Quad bikes are only allowed between 7h00 – 21h00.

Please keep to the speed limits at all times!



-CAN I DRIVE ON THE BEACH?

You are welcome to drive on the launch site & between the demarcated areas only.

-WHERE IS THE NEAREST TOWN & PETROL STATION?

Xai Xai is situated +-35 km before you reach the resort. There is a Shoprite & Saverite in town.

-WHAT IS THE BEST MALARIA PRECAUTION?

Each bed has their own mosquito net & the resort is sprayed on a regular basis to prevent mosquitoes. It is advisable to use extra repellents. Please enquire with your doctor which medication suits you best.

-DO YOU HAVE A LAUNDRY SERVICE?

Yes, there is a laundry service available.

-IS THERE SECURITY AT THE RESORT?

There is 24hour security at the resort, as well as cameras at the gate. Please refrain from leaving any valuables in your vehicle.

-DO I NEED TO BRING MY OWN CLEANING PRODUCTS?

No, each Villa is cleaned on a daily basis. Cleaning products as well as toilet paper will be provided.
