3. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

- 3.1. Friedel Kirstein delivered his report.
- 3.2. The 40th birthday bash was one of the highlights of the year.
- 3.3. The golf day was replaced with a wingshoot weekend which proved very successful.
- 3.4. Consideration will be given to increasing the size of the wingshooting party but this is dependant on the venue.
- 3.5. Based on the venue used this year, the wingshooting party is already at its limit and cannot be increased.
- 3.6. Members were reminded that event was a first come, first served event and the same would apply next year.
- 3.7. Members requested more social events and when a whisky tasting evening was organised it had to be cancelled due to lack of interest.
- 3.8. The committee will investigate alternative social events along the hunting / shooting theme as more interest has been shown in these non-angling events.
- 3.9. Currently looking into an event associated with the big bore rifle association.

SUB-SECTION REPORTS

5. SOUTHERN GAUTENG / SADSAA

- 5.1. SGDSAA Delegate Report
 - 5.1.1. Rosebowl is being hosted by East Rand from 10-14 May 2010 at Sodwana Bay.
 - 5.1.2. No financials available as minutes are not out from the last SGDSAA meeting.
 - 5.1.3. Specific process changes instituted has resulted in an increase in the reporting of income for the zone.

- 5.1.4. Nic van Zyl (zonal records officer) has reviewed the results from the Nomads Closed and has advised that there are many vacant African Waters records that members should apply for.
- 5.1.5. Albatros Skiboat Club, located at Three Rivers in Vereeniging, has joined the zone.
- 5.1.6. Provincial nominations must be emailed to the club chairman and the zonal secretary along with the deposit slip for the R50 nomination fee.
- 5.1.7. The deposit slip must be emailed / faxed to the zonal financial officer.
- 5.2. Results for year included see appendix 1 on page 9 (Nomads members in blue)
- 5.3. SADSAA report back.
 - 5.3.1. Salient points:
 - Surveyors wanting to do buoyancy on boats must do a course and their cards will be endorsed with buoyancy status on them.
 - Every SADSAA hosted National event will have Netcare assistance on standby as this is a government stipulation. SADSAA to pay. Only in effect at Sodwana, Cape Vidal and Mapelane.
 - Trailer regulations discussed.
 - Gamefish Nationals rules to change for 2010 no jigging and braid line.
 - Tuna, Marlin/Sailfish Nationals rules to remain the same.
 - Tournament catch returns to be submitted to Dr Bruce Forbes for competitions hosted in RSA waters.
 - Category C students wanting a licence are not allowed to do an exam until the practical has been done.

6. PRO/WEBSITE

- 6.1. Members who complain for not receiving their emails are to please check the following:
 - Has your email address changed and you failed to notify the club?
 - Is your mailbox full?
 - Has your mail been blocked by your company or ISP?
 - Has your mail been marked as SPAM?
- 6.2. Members are advised that they can read all the latest news on the website as well as contact the club via the website or follow the club on Facebook.

7. SAFETY

- 7.1. Dave Brown reported that there are a number of problems regarding Cat-R boats mostly to do with buoyancy.
- 7.2. It has also been reported that there are invalid buoyancy certificates being issued.

- 7.3. No SADSAA safety officer may issue any buoyancy certificate unless they have successfully completed the buoyancy course and this is endorsed on their safety card.
- 7.4. Dave Brown advised that there has been a change to the issuing of SR numbers.
- 7.5. These will, in future, only be issued by Zelda at Camping & Boating
- 7.6. Kevin brown has offered to assist members with fault investigations with their radios at boat testing.
- 7.7. Fire extinguishers may be serviced on site during the annual boat test on Saturday 21 November 2009.
- 7.8. Boat owners are advised that they must bring a copy of their buoyancy certificate with them.

8. RECORDS

- 8.1. Nothing to report.
- 8.2. Nic van Zyl has reviewed the results from the Nomads Closed and has advised that there are many vacant African Waters records that members should apply for.
- 8.3. It was decided that a copy of the latest records would be available at the weigh-in at future for members to check their catch against current record.

9. COMPETITIONS

- 9.1. Rosebowl 2010
 - 9.1.1. Mitchell Moore will again be the Nomads captain.
 - 9.1.2. There has been a change in the arrangement and collection on the prize giving side where each club is equally responsible to raise R35K as their contribution to the competition.
 - 9.1.3. There will be four (4) categories of line class: **6kg**, **10kg**, **24kg** and **37kg**
 - 9.1.4. Generally Nomads has the most entries (boats & anglers) which, based on the current rules, tends to handicap the club.
 - 9.1.5. Tackle boxes will be arranged in the New Year.
 - 9.1.6. The scoring format is still under discussion and has not been finalised.
 - 9.1.7. Mitchell reminded all the members that the Rosebowl is a team oriented event and not an individual event.

9.2. Nomads Closed 2009

- 9.2.1. Colin Green thanked all the sponsors for their contribution towards the competition.
- 9.2.2. Some problems were experienced with the authorities in Ponta viz:
 - It is becoming harder to fish in the area due to imposed regulations
 - The authorities are planning to limit the number of boats and / or anglers in the area.

- The reluctance to issue fishing permits before the competition.
- 9.2.3. It was felt that Nomads should look at other more-fishing oriented venues.

9.3. Nomads Closed 2010

- 9.3.1. It seems that in October there has been a lot more wind than in the past.
- 9.3.2. Possible consideration of moving the competition earlier to June July.
- 9.3.3. This period has a five (5) week school holiday and it coincides with the soccer world cup.
- 9.3.4. Two possible dates were put forward 21/6 26/6 and 28/6 2/7 but no date has been selected.
- 9.3.5. Members were asked to please include their juniors into the competition and next year would be a great opportunity since it would be over a very long school holiday period.

9.4. October 2010.

- 9.4.1. Possibly plan another trip to Kenya similar to the one Nomads did a few years ago.
- 9.4.2. Basil Hill has been contacted and the current 2009 prices are:
 - R17,500 per angler or R12,700 per non-angler
 - Based on 7 days in Kenya, 4 days fishing, airport transport, accommodation and meals
 - Excludes alcohol and refreshments
- 9.4.3. More details will be made available at a later stage.

10. DEVELOPMENT

- 10.1. Dave Brown reported that the bi-annual SGDSAA development course was again held this year.
- 10.2. The course consisted of a theory day and one of two practical days (gamefishing at Shelly beach or bottom fishing at Christmas Rocks in East London.
- 10.3. The theory day was held on 20 June 2009 which was attended by 50 delegates.
- 10.4. The gamefishing practical was held 16-18 July.
- 10.5. Southern Gauteng skippers entered their boats for the teams to fish from and learn from the skippers and their assistants.
- 10.6. There were thirty anglers (30) and eleven (11) boats for the gamefishing event.
- 10.7. Three (3) full days of fishing was achieved with approx. 1.2 tons of fish weighed.
- 10.8. Top boat went to Ian van Zyl [Nomads] (*AQUA BLIS*) with Neil Coetzer [East Rand] (*KATHAZA*) taking second and Mike Schneider [Shelly Beach] (*MUST BYTE*) third.
- 10.9. Top angler went to Elise Roux, Dawie Scholtz was second and Marcus Hoffman third.

- 10.10. Most meritorious fish went to Elize Roux with a 14.8kg yellowfin tuna.
- 10.11. The bottomfish practical has six (6) anglers fishing off three (3) boats.
- 10.12. Only thirty (30) fish were landed, the largest being 5kg.
- 10.13. An amount of R2,409.54 was the surplus made on the event after all expenses had been paid.
- 10.14. Thanks to all the members who gave of their time and knowledge thereby ensuring that the development course was again a resounding success.

11. INTERCLUBS

- 11.1. Dave Visser thanked all the members who partook in the Interclub events during 2009.
- 11.2. The past year saw many more nominations than in previous years.
- 11.3. Nominations will be called for closer to the Interclub events with email correspondence being sent to all members.
- 11.4. For 2010, Dave would like to see more senior / older club members becoming involved and leading teams at the interclubs.
- 11.5. 2010 Rosebowl Sodwana Bay planning will commence in the New Year.

12. GOLF DAY

- 12.1. There was no golf day for the past year.
- 12.2. Mike Koch reported that if the members wanted a golf day, it would be considered in line with the last event held at Sun City.
- 12.3. The committee felt that a wingshooting event was more advantageous for the club.

13. CLOTHING

- 13.1. Wynand Wiering has relocated to Parys and has given up the clothing portfolio.
- 13.2. All the Nomads clothing is stored at the clubhouse.
- 13.3. A new committee member is required to take over this portfolio.

14. SOCIAL / CLUBHOUSE

- 14.1. The club has been advised that the landlords (East Rand) will be making changes to the existing structures to address leaking a roof.
- 14.2. Nomads will be asked to contribute to these changes at it would enhance the current Nomads club house.

15. GENERAL

16. ELECTION OF NEW COMMITTEE

- 16.1. The entire committee stepped down and Carl Krause took over the proceedings to elect a new chairman as well as the committee members.
- 16.2. The existing committee was thanked for their efforts, then asked to step down before the voting process could commence.
