## Fishing Captain Releases his 25,000th Billfish

Think catching one marlin or sailfish is a big deal? How about being with someone who has caught and released 25,000?

Sportfishing Capt. Ron Hamlin completed the feat in April 2008. He works out of the Pacific Fins Resort in Guatemala.

Hamlin credits the incredible Guatemalan fishery as one of the keys to his success. "Let me put it this way," Hamlin explains. "It took me 35 years to catch 3,000. The last 22,000 I've caught during my 14 years in Guatemala." Averaging as many as 2,500 billfish a year, Hamlin says, "You can't do this anywhere but Guatemala." And Hamlin should know. He's fished all over the world.
