How does that work where you get 150 for 3 species, another 50 for 4 species and than another 100 points for 5 species and so on. It was like a penalty for catching the 4th species and that alone could have won the comp for us. We missed that in the rules and should have picked that up....sorry guys.

An extra 5 fish of 4 kg would have won the comp for us. Overall Nomads fished very well with a great atmosphere amongst the guys and I think we all had a great time. The spirit amongst everyone "other clubs included" was brilliant. We made alot a new friends with the ERBC boys. They seem to be stepping up to the plate. The TSC guys where very gracious and the chairman and captain of TSC both expressed their unhappiness with the "Blow out" to me.

The top Boat was Friedel with Nico and Dumin aboard and they gave the rest of us a hiding. The 2nd top boat was *Sea Quest* (TSC) *Shaya Lo Manzi* was third, *Nauti Boy* was 4th and *Voice Mail* (TSC) was 5th.

I believe TSC is engineering their numbers to take the RoseBowl, 10 boats against 10 boats, but an extra 16 anglers on Nomads team means we have to have 30% more points than TSC to be on the same level as them. Thanks guys, Mitchell
