Fishing Competition Summary for 2008

Judging by the amount of emails I have received in response to the paper "Fishing competitions in iSimangaliso: An assessment and analysis of those carried out during 2008" the emotions are running high.

The actual problem statement is defined in the Executive Summary "...reduce competition fish mortality".

Based on this statement and their recommendation of calling for competitions held in iSimangaliso to be "catch & release" oriented, the current SADSAA scoring system can no longer be used.

This proposal raises some interesting aspects pertaining to future competitions but the current competition system does not cater for this.

Maybe it is time for the angling powers to be proactive and come up with a guideline which addresses the concerns raised in the paper.
