We unfortunately only fished one day as a cyclone arrived, down scaling to a tropical storm, and we had a blow out for two days. (We thought we have storms, this was a mother).

A very far away place to travel, 36 hours in the plane, but boy what a place to fish. We stayed at Pompona Beach Club, a really great hotel and only 10 minutes to the fishing grounds.

I caught this Marlin at a reef called Challenger Banks.
