I am very pleased to advise you that, once again, Driftwood Beach Club and Kingfisher Boats - even through these difficult times - have arranged a splendid NETT package for the Nomads competition this year. The NETT US Dollar package - which is to be paid to Driftwood Beach Club on Sunday 4th November 2012 in US Dollars - CASH ONLY - the cash notes to be dated AFTER the year 2000. US\$ Travellers cheques and credit cards are not accepted at the hotel and banks in Malindi. At the present time, the exchange rate for Rand/US\$ is good - so the package price is excellent. 2012 Nomads Fundraiser at the Boksburg Barnyard



Capsized Boat Makes 3,500-Mile Journey to Spain



More than three years after a rogue wave tossed Scott Douglas and Rich St. Pierre from their 26-foot Regulator off Nantucket, the boat has washed up over 3,500 miles away in Spain, according to a report in the Nantucket Inquirer & Mirror.

The Queen Bee was found near the town of Llanes by the Spanish Coast Guard, according to the report. It was covered in barnacles, but both outboards were still attached and intact.

"We heard this huge roar and looked immediately to our left and there was a huge wave that was cresting and breaking above the top of the boat," St. Pierre told the Inquirer & Mirror. "The next thing I knew we were both in the water and the boat was taking off away from us."
