

Nomads Interclub Captain Duties

Any Nomads member who is selected as a captain of a Nomads Interclub team needs to exercise the following duties:

- A) Liaise with team members with regards to tournament.
- B) Arrange entry, booking of the accommodation, travel arrangements and all information relevant to the tournament.
- C) The Captain is to make sure that all members have the correct clothing to attend the competition. He must liaise with the Nomads Clothing Officer to order any shortages of his team.
- D) He must have the necessary tackle checks of his team before the competition. If necessary he must organise tackle boxes / training for the team utilising experienced anglers in the club. This can be organised by the Chairman of the club.
- E) He must within 7 days of completion of the competition submit the <u>Inter Club Competition</u> <u>Report</u> form and <u>expense sheet</u>.
- F) His team members must complete the <u>Captain's</u> <u>report</u> and submit to the Chairman of Nomads.
