Nomads Boat testing: 12 October 2013

Please ensure that all your documentation is up to date and that you are in possession of a valid buoyancy certificate. If your documentation is not correct, no inspection will be done! You will have to make alternative arrangements to have your vessel inspected.

Survey information and checklists may be downloaded from SAMSA <http://www.samsa.org.za/content/survey-information-and-checklists>

The following documents must be available and presented for inspection and ratification BEFORE any seaworthy inspection will be carried out on your boat.

1. Valid skippers licence with the correct grading
2. Ensure that the buoyancy certificate is valid and contains the following information:
 - The details of the issuing authority
 - The boat (name or serial number) in which the certificate is issued
 - Date of issue
 - Date of expiration
 - Details of buoyancy found on the craft
 - **No buoyancy affidavits will be accepted**

3. Valid 29Mhz ICASA licence or proof of payment
4. If your boat has a VHF radio installed on board,
 - A valid VHF ICASA licence or proof of payment
 - VHF operators licence (permanent or un-expired temporary licence)
 - Marine radio card of instructions

Additional checks to ensure that your seaworthy inspection will meet the required standards:

1. Ensure the trailer of the vessel is roadworthy and marked with the owners contact details
2. Ensure that all the necessary safety equipment is still within the marked time period before expiration
3. Ensure that the fire extinguishers are serviced
4. Ensure that the vessel has the correct lifejackets
