## Call for Nominations

Closing date to SGDSAA being 31st March 2019.

Nominations are hereby called for suitably qualified anglers to nominate for the following;

A three person team to represent South Africa (Protea Colours) at the 2019 Hawaiian International Billfish Tournament to be held at Kona Hawaii between the 27th July and 4th August 2019. This is a Heavy Tackle Billfish Tournament. The entry fee is around \$4,000 USD per person which excludes accommodation and airfares.

A three person team to represent South Africa (Protea Colours) at the 2019 Billfish International to be held at Club Nautico de San Juan Puerto Rico to be held at San Juan between 13th August and 18th August 2019. This is a Heavy Tackle Billfish Tournament. The entry fee is around \$3,000 USD per person which excludes accommodation and airfares.

A three person team to represent SADSAA, a three person team to represent SADSAA masters and a three person team to represent SADSAA under/19 at the 2019 Bottom fish Nationals to be held at Durban Ski Boat Club, Durban and hosted by the NDSAA between 15th and 19th August 2019. This is a 10kg line class tournament. The entry fee is R 9,756 per team which includes all meals by excludes accommodation and boat fuel.
