### Message from the Committee

Due to the Corona outbreak all fishing competitions have been cancelled by SADSSA....until further notice.

Through our affiliation to SADSAA we fall under the auspice of the Department of Sport and are bound by the regulations as instituted by SASCOC. With specific reference to competitions: gatherings of more than 100 people will be prohibited It is recommended that all sports competitions/tournaments be cancelled or postponed until further notice. Should your event consist of fewer than 100 people (athletes, officials and spectators) and you are considering continuing with the event, special permission must be granted: first by the provincial department of health and then by the deputy director general of national department of health. Our Closed is just over two months away and it is hoped that by then Covid-19 will be under control and we will be able to host the competition as planned. We will not have as many people as 100 so we will explore the option of special permission. In the meantime, we need to be responsible and do our part to prevent the spread of the virus - so for now we will continue to plan the Closed for the end of May, but please don't get upset with the organisers if we have to pull the plug closer to the time.

### **Nomads Closed**

In light of the current state of affairs pertaining to the Corona Virus, and the resultant lockdown of 21 days (maybe longer) we have had to consider our options regarding the Closed. Following this lockdown, the country is going to be in a difficult financial space. The committee foresees that it will be difficult for anglers to take leave just a few weeks after the lockdown (if it is not extended). With the above in mind, the committee must, unfortunately, make a tough call. It was decided NOT to cancel the 2020 Closed competition, but rather to postpone it and wait until we have a more definitive idea of where Covid-19 is taking us. If all goes well we are looking at October at the same venue. We wish all of you and your families well in this difficult time and hope that everyone remains safe and responsible. **A** Organising committee.
