Boat testing

The duration of annual seaworthy (COF) certificates are valid for a fiscal year. A calendar year is always January 1 to December 31. A fiscal year, by contrast, can start and end at any point during the year, as long as it comprises a full twelve months. Thus, the vessel owner may determine when they wish to have their vessel surveyed. If successful, the COF will then remain in effect for a full 12 months from the date of inspection. The onus now rests with the vessel owner to determine when they wish to have their vessel surveyed.

The SAMSA COF forms for CAT B/C/D/E/R have been updated and are available for download from the SAMSA website: http://www.samsa.org.za/Pages/Survey-Information-and-Checklists.aspx. The owner of the vessel needs to download the appropriate category document and complete it prior to having their vessel inspected.
