Please note the following:

- No fishing may take place in any of the Restricted or Wilderness zones of the MPA, including the DAR 1 & 2 Barges South of Cape Vidal and the Sodwana Diving Restricted zone.
- Only pelagic gamefish as per Annexure 2 of the MPA regulations maybe caught.
- The Total Daily Bag Limit of fish is Five (5) per angler, irrespective of species
- The Catch and Release of fish is encouraged.
- KaaKaap/Green Jobfish (*Aprion virescens*) MAY NOT be caught or kept.
- All Sharks, Rays, Kingfish species and Billfish are to be released.
- All anglers possess valid fishing permits.
- Internal Park Rule 03/2009 - No stainless-steel hooks or Vertical Jigging Equipment is allowed.
